The paper scope seems to be on digital economy as mentioned in the title. Please clarify it if possible as it is a very interesting paper. Methods: I appreciate your efforts and the choice of a narrative review methodology (<i>Research design</i>). Explain the <i>sample</i> choice. Please, provide more details on the sample inclusion/ exclusion criteria. In addition, mention the research validity and reliability procedure.
