A minimum of 3-4 sentences may be required for this part.</b>	The manuscript shed light on the demography of cumin farmers in India, what motivates their use of pesticides and the problems they face cultivating the crop.	
<b>Is the title of the article suitable? (If not please suggest an alternative title)</b>	No, the title is a bit unclear and there is tautology. A possible suggestion is: <b>"Farmers' Purchasing Behavior of Insecticides and Challenges in Cumin Cultivation in Dhrol Taluka, Jamnagar District, Gujarat, India."</b>	
<b>Is the abstract of the article comprehensive? Do you suggest the addition (or deletion) of some points in this section? Please write your suggestions here.</b>	The abstract is very comprehensive except for a few grammatical or spelling blunders. First, there was 'non-prabability.....' under the method which I presume the author meant 'non probability.' Also, not so sure 'Raising costs' is more suitable than 'Rising costs' under 'Findings'.	
<b>Is the manuscript scientifically, correct? Please write here.</b>	To the best of my knowledge, maybe yes. Except that the manuscript contains too many grammatical or spelling errors that I lost counts. Also there are repeated sentences – <i>line 15</i> under '1.1 Introduction' has same information as <i>line 2</i> under '1.2 Indian Scenario of Agrochemicals.' I would suggest major copyediting.	
<b>Are the references sufficient and recent? If you have suggestions of additional references, please mention them in the review form.</b>		
<b>Is the language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</b>	No, it is not. As suggested previously, the clarity and tenses needs to be improved on.
