This makes it a very versatile plant and therefore a study on its nutritional value only goes further to inform the scientific community of its importance. This of course can further shape policy decisions as well as public knowledge and perception of this "functional food" plant

Find an alternative below; "Nutritional Value of Moringa oleifera cultivated under the Semi-Arid Conditions of Sudan" Also, just saying "Moringa oleifera is very vague. What part of the Moringa did you use in this study? Was it the leaves, roots, seeds etc.....?", make sure you indicate what part of the the Moringa plant was used	
<b>Is the abstract of the article comprehensive? Do you suggest the addition (or deletion) of some points in this section? Please write your suggestions here.</b>	You need to redo your abstract; at the level of the conclusion. What is the implication of the study? The answer is what you need to put in the concluding part of your abstract	
<b>Is the manuscript scientifically, correct? Please write here.</b>	The manuscript is lacking in scientific aspects. The presentation needs to be reviewed and should follow the guidelines of the journal. The methodology lacks references and is very scanty. The results are so scanty just like the discussion and citations of other published works What statistical tool was used to analyse your data? You must include that	
<b>Are the references sufficient and recent? If you have suggestions of additional references, please mention them in the review form.</b>	The references are not sufficient and recent enough. 80 % of references are beyond 10 years which is not good enough given the amount of research that has been carried out on Moringa. You need to update your references. I recommend that your references should be at least 70 % recent	
<b>Is the language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</b>	You need to work extensively on your English, especially in presentation. I recommend you use Grammarly to check the appropriateness of your manuscript before submission	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	Why the insistence on the word "semi-arid conditions"? That seems like a keyword but I can't see the rationale for emphatically including that. Justify your use and emphasis on "semi-arid conditions". Again, a lot is missing in your materials and methods. Include all equations used and abbreviations should be made clear. What part of the moringa plant was used? The manuscript needs major revisions as recommended in the previous section
